Giving When It Counts

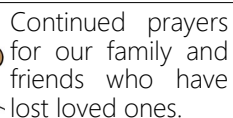

THOUGHTS ON TODAY'S VERSE

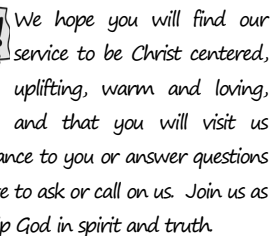
