After establishing that the customer had a numeric-only pager, the light bulb came on. "How does she spell her name?" the service rep asked.

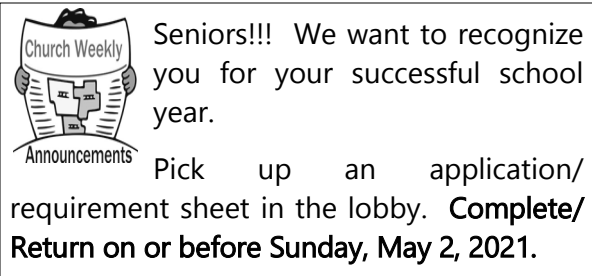
"L-O-W C-E-L-L"
