## MISSED OPPORTUNITIES

The story is told of a young man who wished to marry the farmer's beautiful daughter. He went to the farmer to ask his permission. The young man stood in the pasture awaiting the first bull. The barn door opened and out ran the biggest, meanest-looking bull he had ever seen.
