### OUR GOD IS MERCIFUL

The prophet Jeremiah bemoaned the fall of Jerusalem to the Babylonians in the sixth century BC, long after his warnings of God's approaching wrath had gone unheeded. He turned, in a stunning act of faith, to remember God's unending mercy as he vented his pain:

*But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope:  
The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases' His  
mercies never come to an end; they are new every  
morning; great is your faithfulness* (Lamentations 3:22-23).

God showed mercy despite the fact that mankind had failed to come back to Him and everything was in ruins. When the dust covered the ruins of Jerusalem, his mercies began to shine once again, starting with a small group of his people that he managed to save in order to rebuild what had been destroyed. This redemption finally resulted in a plan of redemption through Christ for the entire human race.

The same mercy that Jeremiah praised still exists today (You should be really happy about that). The love and compassion that God has shown people throughout the ages continue to descend upon us, even as changes force us to our knees (Malachi 3:6). Disaster might happen to us more than once in our lives. We must be mindful that disaster is apart of life. One of the prominent facts about disaster is that it will cause our life structures to fall to pieces. However, in his kindness, he uses all of these disasters for the benefit of those who love him. Paul would say it this way, "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God and who are called according to His purpose" (Romans 8:28). We experience pandemics, illness, and loss, yet the dust will settle, the Son will come again, and his mercies, which are new every morning, will never end. ~Selected
